Dear Parents,

Term 2 is certainly flying and we are really looking forward to a great 4 weeks to finish off! Teachers are busy writing reports and students have been working very hard on literacy and numeracy tasks, lots of sporting activities and leadership opportunities.

Correct Winter Uniform Please!

June and winter are upon us! Please ensure your child comes to school each day dressed appropriately, especially children who arrive on early buses. All winter uniform is available from the office and the uniform shop which is run by Mrs Jones on a Tuesday afternoon from 3.30pm. Coats, beanies, gloves etc need to be navy blue in colour. Big W and Target have a good range for schools. Navy tights are to be worn with tunics. Western Region jumpers are ONLY to be worn during sporting days, carnivals or matches. A uniform order form is available on our website. As a requirement of school and department policy, NSW children are expected in school uniform each day.

Early Buses and Teacher Duty

Please be aware that our teachers do an extra 45 minutes of duty each day to cater for students that arrive via buses before the recommended half hour before school.

During this time the duty is called **INACTIVE**. That means that staff are on site but NOT actively in the playground. Children are to sit in the COLA and wait until the teacher comes on duty at the specified time of 8.55 (half an hour before bell time). This has been an ongoing issue with bus companies for many years and we always ensure that our children are safe with our duty of care.

To ensure that we abide by the guidelines and for evacuation purposes, children, who walk to school, catch later buses or who are dropped off are NOT to be at school before 8.55. We do understand however that occasionally parents need to drop children off early. *If this is the case then we ask that parents notify the school and make arrangements. We then know your child will be on site early.* We appreciate your support with this matter.

Half Staff Development Day

Our staff will be participating in a half Staff development day on Tuesday 13th June from 3.30-6.30pm. Staff will complete training on the NDIS (National Disability Insurance Scheme), Modules 4-8 of Disability Standards and updates to Anaphylaxis online training. This half day, along with our day in term one will replace the Professional learning day which is normally held at the end of Term 4. Staff will finish the same day as students in Term 4 on Friday 15th December.

Premier's Sporting Challenge

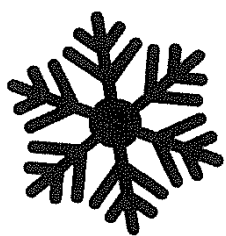

NEWBRIDGE WINTER SOLSTICE

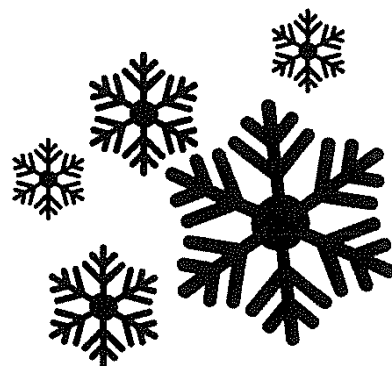
Saturday 17th June
