Over the past week our staff have been analysing our NAPLAN results. We are very excited by the outstanding results particularly in Reading and Numeracy. Worth mentioning is that 68% of our Year 3 students are in the top 2 bands in Reading and 91% of our Year 5 students made growth equal to or greater than expected. All our hard work on Infants Reading Programs and our Numeracy Continuum Groups is definitely paying off! Well done Staff and Students!

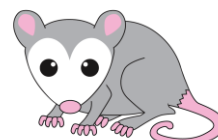
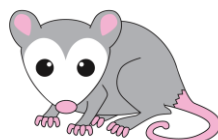
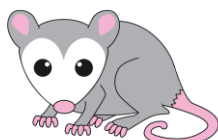
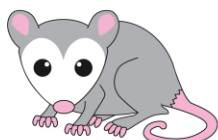
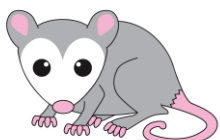
LMBR Update – We Go Live Next Week!

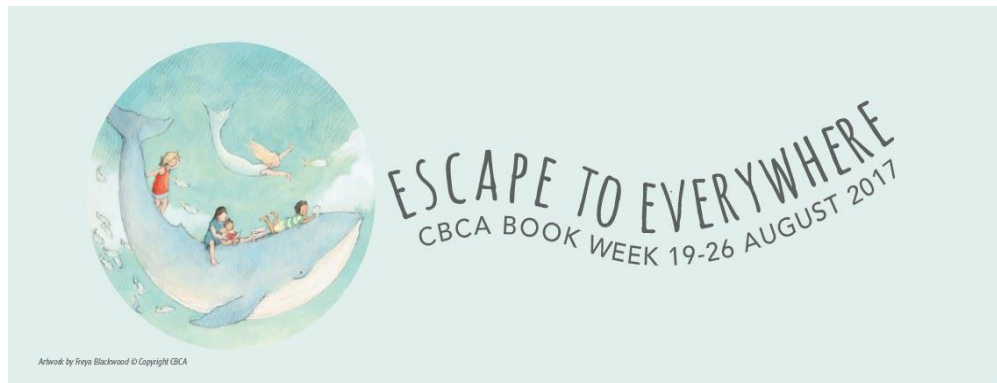


This Friday Father's Day Stall

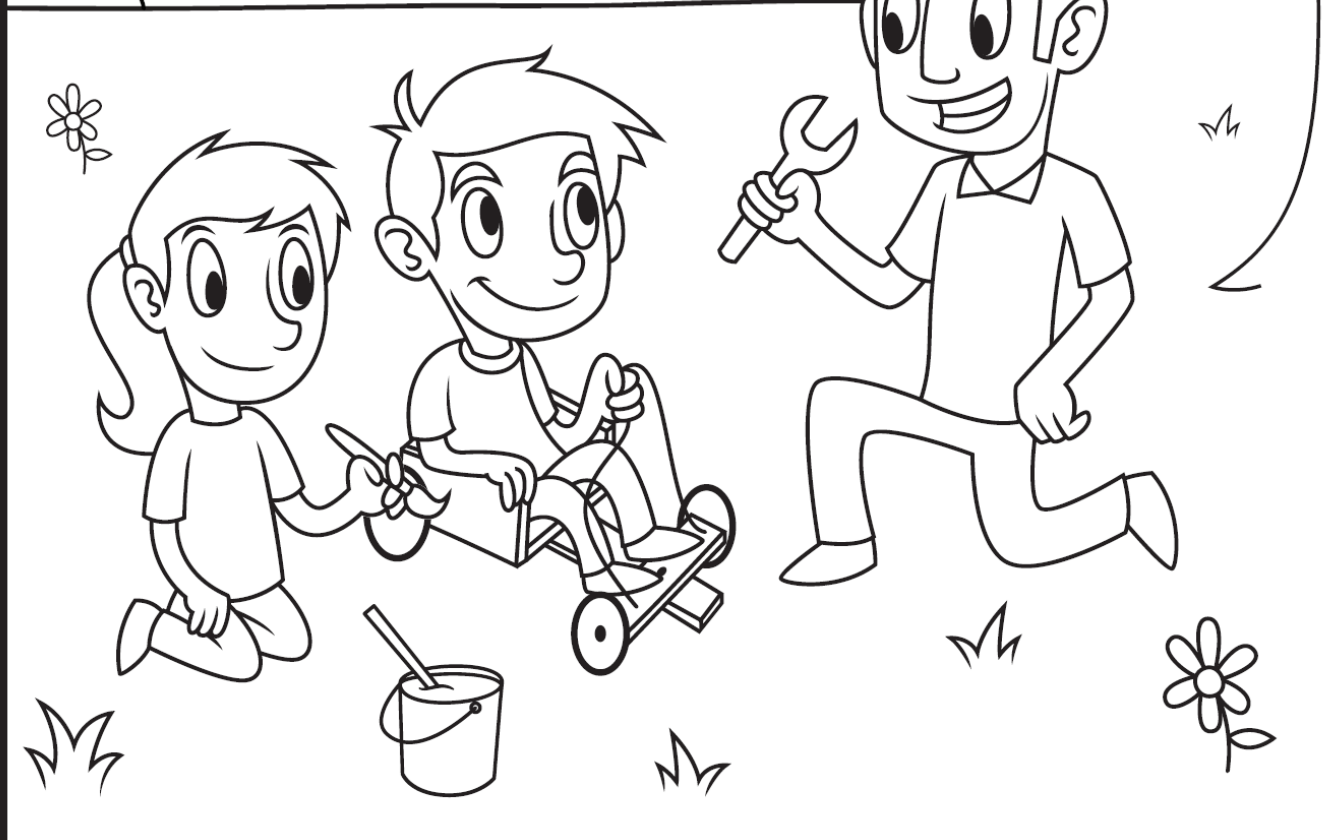
