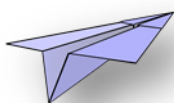

This is an excellent achievement for such a new Service and is a tribute to the efforts of the Staff and support from the children, families and Perthville School.



PAPER PLANES – the past few weeks the children have been very involved in designing and creating paper planes. They also watched a short instructional clip on making paper planes. The planes were then used outdoors in competitions. They measured distances, discussed speeds and directions and kept records on a white board.
