Band Payments

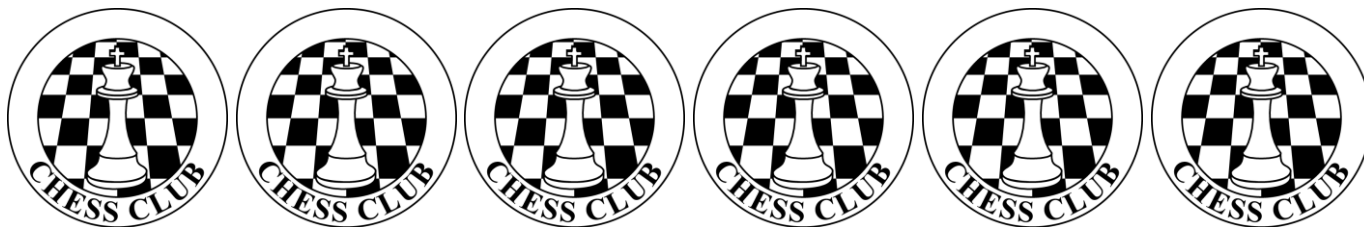
Invoices for band have been sent home today. Please ensure these fees are paid promptly as band is taught by Mr Brent Dickson who is an external provider.

First Day Food & drink

All students need a day pack with packed recess, lunch and afternoon tea, plenty to drink, water bottle. All in a disposable container.

Departure and Return Arrival Times

Please be at the Bathurst Court House no later than **6.20am** on Wednesday 25th May so we can leave on time at 6.30am. We anticipate our arrival back to Bathurst to be at **5pm on Friday 25th**.

Please ensure you are on time to collect your child and if someone else is collecting them, your teacher or I have that information.

School Uniform & Warm Clothes
