
Mrs James on Leave

Perthville Possums - Kindergarten Transition to Start Next Term



Programming The Future (PTF) Our Digital Education Plan

The PTF Bathurst Team (Rein and Angela) have been working with us to develop our teacher's knowledge and access to the latest technologies. The program is all about making sure Country kids have the same opportunities with Technology as City kids.

To achieve this, the team upskill teachers, ensuring they are ready and confident to deliver a curriculum rich in the latest technologies.

The team has helped us to write a digital education plan that guides the implementation of our Term 4 'Tech Heads' program and continued implementation of the latest technologies for the next 2 years.

They train, support, offer courses and assist us with running all programs over that time. We have invested in the latest hardware and software to run these programs.

The programs on offer include coding, 3D Printing, STEM shareware, Augmented Reality and Sound, Minecraft, Microbits and Movie Production as well as others.

Ms Barlow and Mr Dickson are our technology champions and will lead our team through this new learning.

All students will be taught a range of skills over the next 2 years. We will track our learning and their learning and how they have accessed these new technologies through school.
