

Dear Parents,

We will require bikes to be brought to school to participate in the practical activities (please note the days above). Students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will participate in endurance style riding activities where they will complete a course that will exit the school grounds, follow the pedestrian path around the perimeter of the school and then return to school grounds. Students in K, 1 and 2 will complete endurance style activities on school grounds.
