A Message from Galloping Gumnuts

We have been liaising with the Department to ensure that the school community will still have access to an After School Care program and during Term 4 2022 this will be operated by Big Child Care.

Out of School Hours Care (OSHC)

A company called BIG Childcare will commence our after-school care from Term 4 and we have shared a message from them to you, below.

If your family is interested and **you have not applied yet** for the \$500 per child for their Before & After School Care sessions, you have until **Friday 30th September** to apply for them.

ACTIONS REQUESTED

- I. Families who have not applied through the current provider are to apply on the Service NSW website: https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-basc-voucher
 Once they apply, they will have the BASC voucher sent to them via email.
- 2. Parents/Guardians can then send the voucher, along with the school they will be starting OSHC at to email newschools@bigchildcare.com

When our licence is confirmed by the department, they can start with \$500 credit on their account. What a way to start a relationship!

PLEASE NOTE • While Service NSW have said that transfers of credits between providers are possible, we are yet to hear confirmation of these transfers. We are continually working with Service NSW to see if we can have balances of BASC vouchers scanned with your previous provider, transferred to the Big Childcare enrolment. • The child must be eligible for the vouchers (resident of NSW, aged between 4-13 years old, enrolled in a primary school, listed on a Medicare Card)
