If your child is a pirate, we would love the white t-shirt to be sent in as soon as possible so we can get our creative team to add some pirate stripes!

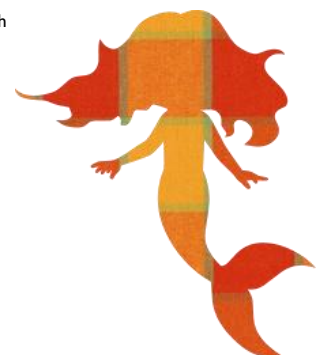

## **K-2 Curriculum Reform**

A review of the current K-2 English and Mathematics curriculum was conducted in 2020 and from the recommendations, a new curriculum has been developed.
