Dear Parents,

Years 4 and 6 have been completing their Check In assessments for Reading and Numeracy this fortnight. These assessments are online and they are mapped to the NSW Syllabuses and National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions. Each assessment is designed to be quick and easy to administer, consisting of between 40 to 50 multiple choice questions. Schools can access results soon after the completion of the assessment to establish future teaching directions.
