Itinerary of approximate times.

- 9am-9.25am arrive at school as normal on the bus or drop off by parent or carer.
- 9.30am travel by private vehicle with a parent or parent helpers (yet to be determined) to Metro 5 cinema, 10am movie starts. Please be aware that the movie could be rated PG
- 12:00pm after the movie has finished the students will walk across to **Panthers Bistro** in the Panthers Complex for lunch. This will consist of Pizzas and soft drink.
- 1pm travel by private vehicle to **Bathurst Tenpin Bowling** which is located at the bottom of Mitre St near the tennis courts.
- 1:15pm begin playing two rounds of Tenpin Bowling.
